The provision of quality health care requires a doctor-patient relationship of trust and confidentiality. Consistent with our commitment to quality care this practice has developed a policy to protect patient privacy in compliance with Privacy Legislation.

It is necessary for us to collect personal information from patients and other health professionals associated with their health care in order to attend to their needs and for administrative purposes. We may also share information with other health care providers. It may be necessary to take de-identified photographs during the management of your condition. Your case will be discussed at a weekly Tumour Board in order to afford you the highest level of multi-disciplinary care.

Research is regularly carried out by doctors to assist in developing improved treatments/cures for diseases. Information relating to your condition/treatment may therefore be used for research and education purposes. Please note that this information will be de-identified and kept anonymous at all times. The research department would also like to keep you updated with research news and community activities.
